#### Legislative News, Jay Smith reporting:

SEMA is asking for support of H.R.3281, the Recognizing the Protection of Motorsports act, known as the "RPM Act", reintroduced in the House of Representatives in the 2021 - 2022 session of Congress. This act will reverse the EPA's ruling that the Clean Air Act prohibits any motor vehicle designed for street use to be converted for use as a race car. This includes cars, trucks and motorcycles.

EPA maintains that the modification of the emission system for racing is illegal. Manufacturing, selling and installing race parts on these vehicles would also be a violation. I'm afraid the manufacturing part here could effect our old car hobby down the road for aftermarket parts. It was also announced by the EPA that enforcement against high performance parts such as superchargers, tuners and exhaust systems is a top priority.

You can read more detail on Sema's web site under legislation. Use their Action Center link to send a message to your Senators and Representative. Ask them to support the RPM Act.
