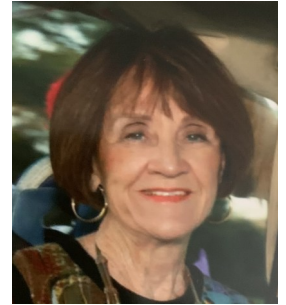
Secretary's Report

The facility teaches various technical skills such as auto mechanics, carpentry, HVAC, plumbing etc. However it also teaches soft skills such as attendance, punctuality and resume building. The third leg of the program helps the students to cope with the life obstacles of the mid 2020s- addiction, broken families, hunger etc.

The program runs 14 weeks and is quite popular with local businesses who recruit from here. We learned that young females seem to be the best welders much to the chagrin of the male students.

After our tour and question and answers the club made a donation of \$200 to the program.


